TEMPORARY COVID-19 BAR & CATERING OPERATIONAL POLICIES

(Latest Update Friday 24th July)

The Rushcliffe Golf Club is committed to creating and maintaining a safe environment for its Members, Visitors and Members of Staff. The following temporary policies have been designed following Government guidelines & have been put in place to protect everyone who visits the Club & therefore must be adhered to.

These measures are only temporary and will be removed or relaxed as soon as possible.

KEY POINTS

*ALL members and visitors MUST register at the designated entry point (Fire Exit 1) on arrival to be seated and MUST leave the venue from the designated exit point (Fire Exit 2). These will be clearly marked

*Tables will be allocated whilst capacity remains

*If seated as a group the entire party MUST register before taking their seats

*Access to the Clubhouse will NOT be allowed from the snooker room or men's changing room/lady's corridor unless already registered and returning from the toilets

*Access to the clubhouse will NOT be offered prior to play, members still must arrive no sooner than 15 minutes before their designated tee time

*For anyone sitting outside there are no guarantees that there will be sufficient available space to transfer tables indoors if the weather deteriorates

*Normal social distancing rules apply at all times

*Please wash your hands frequently and use the sanitizing stations provided

*If seated outside, please DO NOT enter the Clubhouse to use the toilet facilities. Please access the toilets via the men's changing room door or the main entrance door for the men's and ladies' toilets respectively

*Once registered members MUST follow the one-way system in order to order drinks and food and then take their seats at their allocated table

*Tables INSIDE will be limited to 2 people
(or 4 people where the group of 4 only contains individuals from no more than 2 households)

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*Tables OUTSIDE will be limited to 6 people from any number of households

*Tables MUST NOT be moved from their designated positions

*Once seated members MUST NOT move from one table to another interacting with others

*A limited food menu will be in operation

*Oak Lounge will be available for up to 20 people at any one time for plated meals, more information will follow shortly regarding this

*In the interest of fairness members may be asked to leave once they have been seated for more than 1 hour if other members or visitors are trying to use the facilities

*Clubhouse operational hours will be limited to the following:

Monday & Wednesday: 2pm – 5pm

Tuesday: 12pm – 5pm

Thursday & Friday: 2pm – 10pm

Saturday: 12pm – 10pm

Sunday: 12pm – 8pm

*Halfway Hut operational hours will be limited to the following:

Monday – Friday: 10am – 2.30pm

Saturday: 8.30am – 6pm

Sunday: 8.30am – 4pm

*Members can use their bar cards but must top up by providing their bar card number and contactless card payments will be preferred in order to reduce threat of exposure and reduce serving time

*The Coffee Machine is out of use until further notice in order to limit unnecessary exposure

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PENALTIES FOR BREACH

Given the serious nature of the current crisis, alongside the need to ensure that The Rushcliffe Golf Club is doing everything possible to meet its duty of care towards all members, visitors, and staff – if anyone is found to be in breach of any of the points listed below they will be given an initial warning. If they proceed to commit a further breach they will receive an immediate 4-week suspension of membership. These penalties will be applied for the following:

- Anyone found to be using abusive or insulting language towards any member of staff

The initial warning can be given by either the Catering Team or the Club Manager and the suspension will be applied immediately by the Club Manager. This suspension will involve a total ban from use of the Clubhouse facilities. This penalty will not be subject to appeal. Anyone found in further breach will then lose access to the Clubhouse for a further 4-week period.

NB: the decision has been taken that an immediate 4-week suspension of membership will be issued for anyone found drinking alcohol or socialising in the car park or anywhere else on site before or after their round of golf. The suspension will apply immediately with no initial warning issued.
