Dress Code Policy

The dress code for Rushcliffe Golf Club (RGC) reflects its desire for smart, clean and appropriate clothing to be worn in the Clubhouse and on the Course.

On the Course, appropriate clothing should be designed for the game of golf. Shorts may be worn providing they are tailored, of knee length and worn with sports socks (any colour). Sports socks liners are also permissible. Golf shirts should (ideally) be tucked into waist bands and not hang loose and should not be designed for other sports (e.g. football, rugby etc).

<u>In the Clubhouse</u>, it is unacceptable to wear golf caps, vests, ripped or torn denim and the like. Collared shirts are preferable and either tailored shorts or trousers. In hot weather it is acceptable to wear footwear without socks. Some new style dimpled golf shoes can be worn both on and off the Course, these are acceptable in the Clubhouse provided they are clean and dry.

Apart from the above restrictions, RGC will not define what is acceptable or not but will trust members individuals' judgement to wear clothing that reflects its desire for smart, clean and appropriate clothing.

This Dress Code applies to members of RGC.

This Dress Code of RGC will be respectfully advised to anyone wishing to hire any of the facilities at RGC for parties and the like although strict adherence will not necessarily be enforced.
